Full-day Pre-K4

REACH Pre-K4 (4 years old by 10/1/24) offers a multi-sensory, play-based learning environment that encourages exploration and discovery through teacher-guided centers. Our curriculum is based on units of study that are delivered as structured play activities to develop logical thinking and language skills to promote kindergarten readiness. Stimulating multi- sensory classroom centers investigate letters, numbers/math concepts, and pre-reading skills for an integrated and fun approach to learning.

Full-day Transitional Kindergarten (5TK)

REACH 5TK has been designed for the young 5 year old (by 12/31/24) who may benefit from an extra year before entering kindergarten. Our program has been developed to provide a bridge from preschool to kindergarten and is aligned with Ridgewood Public School's kindergarten curriculum and standards. The program uses multi-sensory learning concepts to reinforce key academic areas such as reading readiness, language literacy and math/number concepts.
