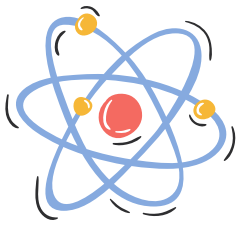

Dear Parents,

This letter is to inform you of the setup and breakdown procedures for the Science Fair. Please follow the directions to ensure a smooth and efficient dropoff and pickup of Science Fair projects.

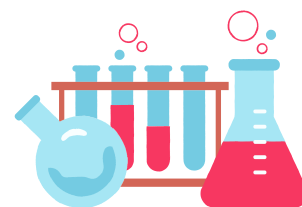
- Projects are to be dropped off at the Travell gym from 4:30 – 6pm on Thursday, March 2. T-shirts will be delivered via classrooms by Thursday morning.
- Please set up your project on your child's grade-level table in the gym.
- Students please wear Science Fair T-shirts for school on March 3.
- Fifth grade students are required to participate.
- Students can have partners but each student must sign up in order to receive their Science Fair T-shirt.
- ALL PROJECTS MUST BE MOUNTED ON STURDY MATERIAL, SO THEY CAN STAND ON THEIR OWN! (e.g. tri-fold, corrugated cardboard, or foam core presentation board, available at stores like Staples)

All classes at Travell will view projects during the day on Friday, March 3rd. Parents are invited to view projects on Friday from 6:15 – 8:00pm.

Grades K-2 from 6:15 – 7:00pm

Grades 3-5 from 7:15 – 8:00pm

All projects MUST be taken home Friday, March 3, after the family visits at 7:15 pm or 8:00 pm depending on your grade time slot. There is no storage available, so please pick-up projects promptly. You can show your project at Super Science Saturday at the RHS:

## Science Fair RULES:

- No fire or any type of open heat source
- No live animals or insects
- No dry ice
- No dangerous or poisonous chemicals (including acetone in nail polish and nail polish remover) (White vinegar and lemon juice are allowed.)
- No food, candy or giveaways allowed during the school day (Food can be part of the experiment)
- No quizzes or contests can be a part of a project
- Please choose age-appropriate projects

**Projects that do NOT adhere to these safety guidelines will NOT be allowed at the Science Fair. There are NO exceptions.**

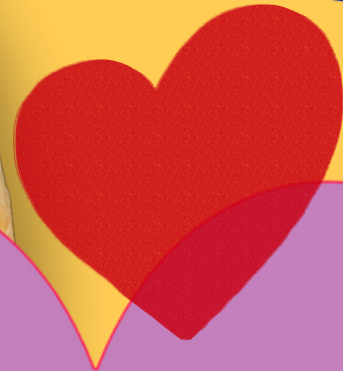

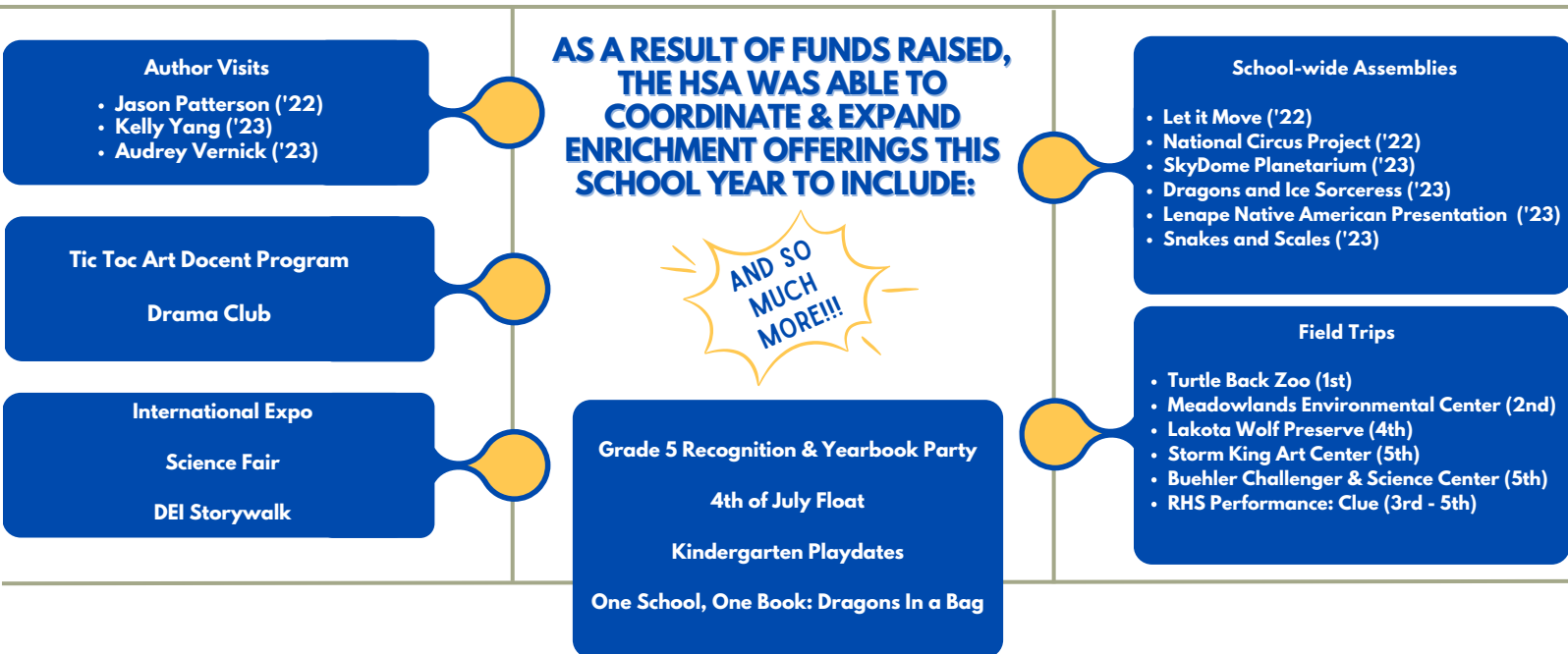


# FRIENDS OF TRAVELL

Dear Travell Families,

The Travell Home & School Association (HSA), with generous financial contributions from Travell families, supports the school curriculum and further enhances student experience, by coordinating, securing, and presenting enrichment programs and special activities to benefit our children. In hopes of providing accessible ways for making donations by ALL families, the HSA organizes fundraising opportunities throughout the year. Our primary fundraisers for enrichment programs are the Travell Auction and "Friends of Travell". These two major fundraisers alternate, with this school year (2022-2023) being a Friends of Travell year. "Friends of" fundraisers are also held at most of the other Ridgewood schools.



Travell HSA's total enrichment costs are approximately \$51,000 per year. **Our fundraising goal for this year's Friends of Travell is \$40,000. We hope to achieve this goal by May 2023.** Additional revenue comes from smaller fundraising initiatives, such as grocery store cards, bake sales, Book Fair, No Cook Nights, among others.

The average cost for enrichment is \$150 per student. However, any donation amount is greatly appreciated and tax deductible.

Every dollar makes an impact and helps enrich the experience of our children throughout the school year. On behalf of the entire Home & School Association, we thank you in advance for your consideration and support.

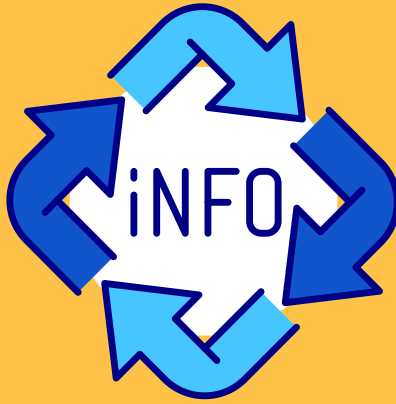
