Program includes:

- Topic based workshops through-out winter/spring. Date/workshops TBD.
- Parenting Mentoring groups offered weekly, day and evening sessions.

- Assistance with balancing busy schedules: ways to de-stress, time-management, discipline, creating structure at home and time for yourself.
- Therapist can collaborate with designated school staff for consultation if needed.
